# AOF Rossnick International Humanitarian Grants Feedback Survey



This fund, established in 2006 through a bequest from Julian and Esther Rossnick, enables AOF to administer individual, supplemental travel grants in various amounts to help pay for airfare for

Osteopathic medical students (II-IV), as well as Osteopathic residents, fellows, and physicians, who have been invited to join an international humanitarian medical trip.

The goal of the grant is to alleviate some of the financial burden associated with international travel; while simultaneously educating, inspiring, and empowering members of the Osteopathic profession to participate in humanitarian medical outreach trips that have an immediate, as well as long term, impact on the patients they will serve.

In 2020, due to the State Department's "do not travel outside the US" advisory, the AOF suspended distributions from the Rossnick International Humanitarian Grants program.

During this time, we are taking time to review, refine, revise and improve the program.
