

Osteopathic Medicine: Continued Growth and Leadership

The field of osteopathic medicine is experiencing remarkable growth and is projected to continue expanding, as evidenced by more than one in four current medical students choosing to pursue osteopathic medicine. Osteopathic physicians (DOs) practice in every medical specialty, combining medical expertise with a whole-person approach centered on listening to and partnering with their patients. Below includes additional current information on osteopathic medicine.

- Osteopathic medicine is one of the fastest-growing health care professions, and there now are **71**% more DOs than a decade ago.
- The total number of DOs and osteopathic medical students is over 186,000.
- DOs are the physicians of the future; **68**% of those actively practicing are under the age of 45.
- 57% of DOs are in primary care specialties.
- DOs practice their distinctive philosophy in every medical field and specialty.
- Throughout history, DOs have been dedicated to helping minority and underserved communities.
